



FINA RULE AMENDMENTS ARE IN EFFECT DECEMBER 3, 2014

The following document indicates the amended or new rules specific to pool swimming which were instituted at the FINA Extraordinary Congress Nov 29, 2014.

Blue = new wording

(New) = new rule

A ‘clean version’ follows.

SW 2 OFFICIALS

SW 2.1 Referee

SW 2.1.6 (New) A disqualification for starting before the starting signal must be observed and confirmed by both the starter and the referee.

SW 2.1.6 (To be renumbered 2.1.7) The referee shall disqualify any swimmer for any other violation of the rules that he personally observes. The referee may also disqualify any swimmer for any violation reported to him by other authorised officials. All disqualifications are subject to the decision of the referee.

SW 2.6 Inspector of Turns

SW 2.6.3 In individual events of 800 and 1500 metres, each an inspector of turns at the start or turning end of the pool shall record the number of laps completed by the swimmer in his lane and keep the swimmer informed of the remaining number of laps to be completed by displaying “lap cards”. Semi-Electronic equipment may be used, including under water display.

SW 6 BACKSTROKE

SW 6.1 Prior to the starting signal, the swimmers shall line up in the water facing the starting end, with both hands holding the starting grips. Standing in or on the gutter or bending the toes over the lip of the gutter is prohibited. When using a backstroke ledge at the start, the toes of both feet must be in contact with the end wall or face of the touchpad. Bending the toes over the top of the touchpad is prohibited.

SW 6.2 (New) When a backstroke ledge is being used, each inspector at the starting end shall install and remove the ledge after the start.

SW 6.2 renumbered to SW 6.3 and thereafter



SW 7 BREASTSTROKE

SW 7.1 After the start and after each turn, the swimmer may take one arm stroke completely back to the legs during which the swimmer may be submerged. At any time prior to the first Breaststroke kick after the start and after each turn a A single butterfly kick is permitted during the first arm stroke followed by a breaststroke kick.

SW 12 WORLD RECORDS

SW 12.1 For World Records and Junior World Records in 50 metre courses, the following distances and styles for both sexes shall be recognised:

Freestyle	50, 100, 200, 400, 800 and 1500 metres
Backstroke	50, 100 and 200 metres
Breaststroke	50, 100 and 200 metres
Butterfly	50, 100 and 200 metres
Individual Medley	200 and 400 metres
Freestyle Relays	4x100 and 4x200 metres
Medley Relay	4x100 metres
Mixed Relays	4x100 metres Freestyle and 4x100 metres Medley

SW 12.1.1 (New) The age groups for World Junior Records are the same as for the FINA World Junior Swimming Championships and can be only recognised in 50 metre courses.

SW 2 OFFICIALS

SW 2.1 Referee

SW 2.1.6 A disqualification for starting before the starting signal must be observed and confirmed by both the starter and the referee.

that **SW 2.1.7** The referee shall disqualify any swimmer for any other violation of the rules he personally observes. The referee may also disqualify any swimmer for any violation reported to him by other authorised officials. All disqualifications are subject to the decision of the referee.

SW 2.6 Inspector of Turns



SW 2.6.3 In individual events of 800 and 1500 metres, an inspector of turns at the start or turning end of the pool shall record the number of laps completed by the swimmer in his lane and keep the swimmer informed of the remaining number of laps to be completed by displaying “lap cards”. Electronic equipment may be used, including under water display.

SW 6 BACKSTROKE

SW 6.1 Prior to the starting signal, the swimmers shall line up in the water facing the starting end, with both hands holding the starting grips. Standing in or on the gutter or bending the toes over the lip of the gutter is prohibited. When using a backstroke ledge at the start, the toes of both feet must be in contact with the end wall or face of the touchpad. Bending the toes over the top of the touchpad is prohibited.

SW 6.2 When a backstroke ledge is being used, each inspector at the starting end shall install and remove the ledge after the start.

SW 7 BREASTSTROKE

SW 7.1 After the start and after each turn, the swimmer may take one arm stroke completely back to the legs during which the swimmer may be submerged. At any time prior to the first Breaststroke kick after the start and after each turn a single butterfly kick is permitted.

SW 12 WORLD RECORDS

SW 12.1 For World Records and Junior World Records in 50 metre courses, the following distances and styles for both sexes shall be recognised:

Freestyle	50, 100, 200, 400, 800 and 1500 metres
Backstroke	50, 100 and 200 metres
Breaststroke	50, 100 and 200 metres
Butterfly	50, 100 and 200 metres
Individual Medley	200 and 400 metres
Freestyle Relays	4x100 and 4x200 metres
Medley Relay	4x100 metres
Mixed Relays	4x100 metres Freestyle and 4x100 metres Medley

SW 12.1.1 The age groups for World Junior Records are the same as for the FINA World Junior Swimming Championships and can be only recognised in 50 metre courses.
