

National Teams Program Apprentice Coach Opportunities

Swimming Canada and the CSCTA have partnered to provide professional development opportunities across the National Senior, Development, Para and Open Water team activities in the role of an “Apprentice Coach”.

Building on the successful inaugural year of the National Team Apprentice Program the CSCTA will once again offer funding towards the successful candidates expenses for four unique opportunities.

Based on an application process, Swimming Canada and the CSCTA will select the coach(es) to attend the specific initiative. This decision is final and binding and is not appealable.

As Swimming Canada works towards its mission of being amongst the world leading swimming nations by 2020, one strategic aim is to enhance the development of a sustainable stream of world leading High Performance Coaches.

- The CSCTA funding will be paid directly to the successful applicant and is available as an advance. The final level of funding available will be based several factors including the projected costs and length of each activity.
- In exchange for the funding the successful candidate will provide the CSCTA with a written report and expenses report within 30 days of the end of the activity. Failure to meet these requirements may result in the withdrawal of funding and the need to repay any paid advances.
- Successful applicants are responsible for all costs to attend any camp or tour

- Arrangements for all travel and logistics will be made entirely through Swimming Canada as Apprentice Coaches, where possible, will be included in the team travel, accommodations and meal plans.
- Apprentice coaches will be asked to provide a pre-payment, and will be invoiced by Swimming Canada for the remainder of the full cost after the event
- Apprentice coaches must:
 - Be available to attend the agreed upon portion of the tour
 - Be available for all team activities
- Successful candidates will be assigned specific tasks and responsibilities by either:
 - Senior Coach, Olympic Program – Martyn Wilby
 - Senior Coach, Paralympic Program – Vince Mikuska
 - National Development Coach, Ken McKinnon
 - Open Water and Distance Coach – Mark Perry
