



MASTERS SWIMMING BULLETIN – March 2020

We are pleased to present our monthly bulletin and update. We are launching the Swimming Canada meet entry management system for your use for the Swim Alberta Masters Provincials and the Swim Ontario Masters Provincials in April and the Canadian Masters Swimming Championships in May. This will be of particular help for those swimmers entering the meet individually and not as part of a team. A complete user guide has been prepared to assist you through the meet entry process. Teams are encouraged to continue using their team management programs to create Hy-tek and Splash files for their entries.

CANADIAN RECORD RECOGNITION

Since September 1, 2019, Swimming Canada has been the official recorder of all Canadian Masters Swimming records. All applications for Canadian and World records **MUST** pass through Swimming Canada for validation.
