The CSCA will offer funding towards the successful candidates expenses for three unique opportunities. Based on an application process, Swimming Canada and the CSCA will select the coach(es) to attend the specific initiative. This decision is final and binding and is not appealable.

- Tour Dates: August 25 – September 5
- Competition: September 1 – 4

Approximate Cost: \$5 000.00

CSCA Funding Available: up to \$ 4 000.00

The successful applicant will be expected to report back to the CSCA and its membership about the opportunity in an agreed upon format.



The CSCA funding will be paid directly to the successful applicant and is available as an advance. The final level of funding available will be based on several factors including the projected costs and length of each activity.

- Successful applicants are responsible for all costs to attend any camp or tour
- Arrangements for all travel and logistics will be made entirely through Swimming Canada as “Assistant Coaches”, where possible, will be included in the team travel, accommodations and meal plans.
- “Assistant Coaches” will be asked to provide a pre-payment, and will be invoiced by Swimming Canada for the remainder of the full cost after the event

“Assistant Coaches” must:

- Be available to attend the agreed upon portion of the tour
- Be available for all team activities
