It is of these exemptions, any swimmer who achieves a record time at a competition that gnizes records at any level (regional, provincial, national etc, whether age group or open) not be recognized for that record unless the coach has advised the referee prior to the start e session that there is a possibility of the record being broken, and the referee insures that swimmer competes with competitors of the same gender for his/her heat.
