#### Entry Procedures:

All entries to be submitted using Hy-tek through the Swimming Canada online system. All entries must contain the **swimmer's name, Swimming Canada swimmer ID and date of birth**. If entering from outside of Canada, please email Hy-tek file directly to the entries email Please enter all events with a time. NT's will not be accepted. Swimmers are limited to a maximum of seven events including the home event

A maximum of three events per session

Deck entries will be limited to swimmers who have registered for the competition through the Swimming Canada online system and will be accepted as long as no new heats are created and at Meet Management's discretion.

#### Official Split Time:

Official Split time request deadline by 30 minutes before the start of the session in which the official split is requested. The coaches are required to fill "Official Split Request Form.

There will be a fee of \$5.00 for each single official split request. The fee is payable to the Clerk of Course at the time of the request.

#### Age Groups:

Individual events

Results will be posted in the following age groups:

• Female: 10&under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & over, Male: 11&under, 12-13, 14-15, 16 & over

### **MEET INFORMATION**

#### Rules:

The meet will be conducted under published FINA and/or WPS rules and regulations supplemented by published and approved Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta rules and regulations. In addition, this meet package shall outline all changes to and specific application of the published rules. Swim Alberta policies and procedures, where appropriate will also apply. Swimming Canada warm-up procedures will be in effect.

Modesty Wear

All swimmers are permitted to race with modesty wear at all competitions sanctioned by Swim Alberta. It is not required to declare the use of modesty wear to the Referee.

Modesty wear is considered additional body coverage using a fabric that is a permeable open mesh textile and would not reasonably be seen to be creating a technical advantage, meaning it does not aid buoyancy, strength, speed, or endurance.

#### Safe Sport:

All interactions between an athlete and an individual who is in a position of trust should normally, and wherever possible, be in an environment or space that is both "open" and "observable" to others.

#### Competition and Diving Readiness Standards:

Entry to competition is limited to participants who have passed Swim Alberta's Competition Swim Test. During competition, swimmers should dive at the Dive Readiness Progression skill level they have achieved.

#### **Diving Rules:**

Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per FINA FR 2.3 and SW 4.1.

Meet Format – Timed Final and Preliminary Events

All events will be swum slowest to fastest

200 Free and 200 IM are timed finals.

#### \*\*\*Event order to be confirmed after deadline date to make session length reasonable\*\*\*

#### Meet Format – Finals Sessions

"A" finals only for 100 events

"A" &"B" finals for 50 events - will only be run if 20 swimmers entered in event (not including exhibition swimmers)

Multi Age Super Final for all events

Events will be swam fastest to slowest.

#### Meet Format - Home Timed Event

> Coaches are to have swimmers times to Clerk of Course by 9:00 am Saturday March 18, 2023.

#### Scratches:

The Swim Alberta Scratch Rule will be in effect for this competition. Except for a swimmer will not be penalized if they miss an event during finals.

To make the meet run more efficiently any last minute scratches would be appreciated until Friday March 17, 2023 by Noon. Please notify us by email, entries@ncsaswim.ca.

Late scratches for timed final events and preliminaries: Submit to the Clerk of Course 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. No re-seeding will occur. Meet Management may collapse heats within an event to optimize meet proceedings.

#### Deck Entries:

Deck Entries will be "Exhibition" only and accepted only if the entry does not create a new heat. 30 minutes prior to the start of the session


