SEEDING:		Seeding will be in order of times entered, slowest to fastest, as converted pursuant to the conversion process as per meet package, followed by swimmers entered with NT (no times).						
	X	Preliminary heat events will be seeded as per SW3.1 with fastest 3 heats circle seeded.						
		 Seeding will be in the following order: All entries times will be converted to Long Course (LC) times, using the default conversion factors in Hy-Tek Meet Manager, and then seeded accordingly in order of times entered. Non-conforming times (yards, etc.) and swimmers entered with NT (no time) will be seeded last. Meet Management reserves the right to combine age groups/events if time requires, and the right to split preliminary session age categories to ensure proper session lengths. There will be an "A" final for male and female 13, 14, 15, 16 & Over. All Relays will be timed finals. The 800 Free and 1500 Free will swim fastest to slowest and will be timed finals with alternating W/M heats. The 400 Free and 400 IM will swim slowest to fastest and will be timed finals. 13 & Over preliminaries will swim combined age groups and will be separated into designated age groups for finals. If necessary 1500 Free events may be limited to 2 heats and the 800 Free to 3 heats of each gender. Those qualifying will be determined by entry time. The fastest 20 for 1500 & 30 for 800 will swim. If necessary 400 Free and 400 IM events may be limited to 3 heats per age grouping (Grouping will be 12& Under /13 & Over) and gender.
