All foreign swimmers and coaches must have primary residence within the province /state or country for which they claim registration. Proof of residency may be green card, student ID, driver's license, college residence or other document as deemed acceptable by Swim Ontario and shall be submitted with the <u>Proof of Residence and Registration Status form</u> to Swim Ontario no later than 7 days prior to start of competition.

		High Points Awards : Awarded by gender and: 12 & under 13-14, 15 & over. Ties will be broken by highest FINA points
		SKINS RACE (13 & Over): 50 Free will run on Friday. Top six 50 Free times (by age and gender) will qualify to Skins Races held on Sunday at the end of the session. Top 6 will qualify to 'prelims', top 4 from prelims qualify to 'semis' and top 2 from semis will qualify to 'finals. Age categories: 13, 14, and 15 & over; each gender.
		Winner of each age and gender category will be awarded a cash prize.
