

Entries and Limitations:

Swimmers are restricted to 4 events plus the kick per session. Afternoon sessions are for racing league swimmers **Swimmers can only swim in one session not both** Coaches should prioritize event entry based on fundamental skills development All Entries must include and entry time. NT's will not be accepted as per SNM rules

Entries Interim process

Entries must be compiled electronically via Team software and REMIT ELECTRONIC ENTRY FILE DIRECTLY TO: fleury1@mymts.net

Entries must include the following: Valid Swimmer ID Correct birthdate Para swimmers must have their classification after their name in the entries. All entries must be accompanied by a time, NT will not be allowed

Refunds:

Meet Management is not obligated to refund entry fees after the entry deadline date

Deck Entries:

Additional swims may be permitted if lane space is available, but no additional heats will be created. Note: swimmers cannot exceed the maximum number of swims indicated per session in Entries and Limitations. Must include Swimmers SNC ID Number. Swimmer/Coach must present the late entry fee of 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the session.

The cost for each deck entry is \$15.00

Payment in cash or cheque payable to Brandon Bluefins must accompany the entry when handed to the clerk of course

These swims will be exhibition only.

Competition:

All changes to the competition or meet package after sanctioning must be approved by SNC prior to the start of the competition or the MSOA during competition.

Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per FINA FR 2.3 and SW4.1 or deck surface.

Structure and Format: Age of a swimmer is determined by their age as of Feb 25th 2023

Session 1:

The competition is Timed Finals and will include the following age groups: Girls: 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over Boys: 10 & Under, 11-13, 14-15, 16 & Over

Session 2:

All the 25m and the 75m races will be judged with "Oops" instead of DQ Focus is on dry land activation warm-up, provide feedback on technical/racing skills, and teach basic mental skills of racing.

Seeding:

Entries will be seeded open (all ages) mixed gender, slowest to fastest Coaches are requested to submit entry times for each entry.

Food on Deck:

The City of Brandon has adopted a "No Food on Deck" policy. Coaches will be responsible for ensuring that their swimmers comply with this policy Coaches are responsible to have their swimmers leave their area of the deck is clean prior to leaving the deck at the end of the session.

Programs:

Will be sent to coaches to distribute to their teams on Thursday Feb 23rd.

Programs will be available for officials and posted on wall outside of the multi purpose room.

Results will be posted on Meet Mobile and on wall just outside of the multi purpose room.

Miscellaneous:

There are lockers at the Sportsplex at a cost of \$.25 per use. Swimmers and volunteers are encouraged to ensure that their belongings are secured to avoid loss
