SAFETY AT COMPETITION:	Swimming Canada and Swim Ontario believes that athletes, coaches, officials, support staff and volunteers have the right to participate in a safe, welcoming and inclusive sport environment that is free of abuse, harassment and discrimination. The <u>Swim Ontario Concussion Management</u> & <u>Swimming Canada Event Photography</u> procedures will be in effect. Anyone wishing to record any part of this event while on the pool deck (video or photographs) must submit a written request to the meet manager. The nature and purpose for these recordings are to be included in the application. This policy includes images obtained by team photographers. Unless approval is obtained, only registered swimmers, registered coaches and volunteer officials are permitted on deck. For complete details click <u>HERE</u> . 	 All current Swimming Canada rules will be followed. All swimmers participating in a provincially sanctioned meets shall be required to comply with swimwear rule GR 5. Click <u>HERE</u> to view full details. Advanced notification for exemption or for clarification of the rule please see the Competition Coordinator. Please note that <u>Swimming Canada Competition Warm-Up Safety Procedures</u> will be in effect. Dive Starts will be from the deep end of the pool from starting blocks or the edge of the pool. 			
ELIGIBILITY:	All athletes must be registered as competitive swimmers and pre-competitive swimmers (see below) with Swimming Canada and have a valid Swimming Canada registration number. This is an invitational meet. Participation is at the full discretion of the host club. This event includes participants from the following clubs: Hanover Swim Club, Halton Hills Bluefins, Breakers Swim Team, Owen Sound Aquatic Club, Orangeville Otters, Huron Hurricanes, Collingwood Clippers • Meet Management reserves the right to further limit individual swims and relays if necessary to adhere to available facility time.			



	• Pre-competitive swimmers are welcome to attend without exceeding the maximum of 1 competition.						
FOREIGN COMPETITORS:	Foreign competitors' entries will not be accepted						
AGE UP DATE:	Ages submitted are to be asJune 3rd, 2023						
ENTRY LIMITS:	Each swimmer is permitted to enter 1, 2 or 3 individual events and a relay. Relay swimmers must also be entered in an individual event in order to compete in a relay.						
ENTRY SUBMISSIONS:	 Entries must be submitted through the Swimming Canada online entries system at www.swimming.ca . Meet Management will not accept entries via email. Deck entries are not permitted. Meet managers not following this procedure will be in non-compliance with Swim Ontario. Any entries outside of the system will negate insurance coverage for the club and its board of directors. Entries must include all attending coaches. 						
	• Entries must be submitted using actual times obtained at a sanctioned swim or as "NT" (no time). Please do not convert LC entry times to SC times. Entry will not be converted. Please do not submit estimated seed times.			C times. Entry times

COACH'S REGISTRATION:	 Meet management will cross reference the list of coaches submitted with entries at this competition with the <u>Swim Ontario Compliance lists</u>. If a coach is not on this list, meet management is obligated to enforce the Swimming Canada policy and not permit that coach to attend the meet. Meet management will forward Swim Ontario a list of coaches who they have found to be in non-compliance. Only coaches registered in the competitive category can attend the event. List of coaches should be submitted with entries. Beginning Dec 1, 2022, only coaches on the compliance list can attend. There will be a brief coaches meeting at the start of warm up in or near the guard office.

SEEDING:	 Seeding will be in the following order: All events will be run as timed finals. Seeding will be in order of times entered, slowest to fastest for all events. 						



MIXED-GENDER:	An exemption from the requirement to swim events in gender separated events due to limited time, developmental opportunities or facility requirements and/or due to a missed swim, where on an exception basis, a referee agrees to have the swimmer swim with a heat of an opposite gender event. In spite of these exemptions, any swimmer who achieves a record time at a competition that recognizes records at any level (regional, provincial, national etc, whether age group or open) will not be recognized for that record unless the coach has advised the referee prior to the start of the session that there is a possibility of the record being broken, and the referee insures that the swimmer competes with competitors of the same gender for his/her heat. In the event that mixed gender swims are permitted, the results must still be posted separately				
	by gender of swimmers.				
CHECK-IN AND SCRATCHES:	Scratches are due 30 minutes PRIOR to the start of the session and are to be made at the Recorder Scorer desk. <u>Relay team submissions</u> are due 30 minutes AFTER the start of the session.				
	• All swimmers are required to check in with the Clerk of Course prior to each event.				
PENALTIES:	No penalty shall be imposed for late or day of scratches or No-Shows				
DECK ENTRIES:	No Deck Entries are permitted				
RECORDS:	 Swim times achieved at this competition will NOT be used for applications of provincial and national records. 				
MEET RESULTS:	Official Results will be posted within 48 hours of completion of the meet to <u>www.swimming.ca</u>
