# Entry Procedures – Deadline Wednesday March 15, 2023, 5:00 p.m.

- Swimmers must commit via team unify by Wednesday, March 15, 2023
- Coaches will set events and limit them to a maximum of 2 individual swims.

## **Entry Rules**

- Meet will be conducted under published FINA and/or IPC rules and regulations supplemented by published and approved Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta rules and regulations
- Swimmer age is determined as of the first day of the swim meet (April 1, 2023)
- This competition is open to all swimmers currently registered with Swimming Canada or a FINA affiliated club
- If not currently registered with Swim Alberta can swim as an exhibition swimmer.
- No meet entry time standards are applicable

## **Entry Fees**

 This is a house meet therefore no entry fees are required for FMSC swimmers as it has been included in the FMSC registration fees

## Age Groups

- Swimmer age is determined as of the first day of the swim meet
- Individual event age groups will be:

Female: 10 & under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & over
 Male: 11 & under, 12-13, 14-15, 16 & over

# Warm-up

## **Meet Format/Seeding**

This meet will be timed finals for all age groups and be run slowest to fastest

#### **Meet Rules**

- Meet will be conducted under published FINA and/or IPC rules and regulations supplemented by published and approved Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta rules and regulations
- This meet package shall outline all changes to and specific application of the published rules
- Swim Alberta policies and procedures, where appropriate will also apply

## **Competition & Diving Readiness**

- Starts will be conducted from starting platforms (blocks) as per FINA FR 2.2 and SW 4.1
- Starts will be conducted from the Deck or Bulkhead as per Canadian Facility Rule CFR 2.3.1 and CSW
- Entry to competition is limited to participants who have passed Swim Alberta's Competition Swim Test
- During competition, swimmers should dive at the Dive Readiness Progressions skill level they have achieved
- Backstroke ledges will be used at this swim meet

## Safe Sport

 All interactions between and athlete and an individual who is in a position of trust should normally and wherever possible, be in an environment or space that is both "open" and "observable" to all

#### **Scratches**

The Swim Alberta scratch rule will be in effect for this competition

## Relays

• There will be no relays for this meet

## **Heat Sheets**

- Coaches will receive heat sheets prior to the start of the event.
- Meet mobile will be updated throughout the meet

- Athletes requiring taping are required to provide a note indicating such from a medical doctor
- Final approval for taping must be provided by the session referee before the start of the meet

## **Modesty Wear**

 All swimmers are permitted to race with modesty wear at all competitions sanctioned by Swim Alberta. It is not required to declare the use of modesty wear to the Referee. Modesty wear is considered additional body coverage using a fabric that is a permeable open mesh textile and would not reasonably be seen to be creating a technical advantage, meaning it does not aid buoyancy, strength, speed or endurance.
